
Delegates could register beforehand to partake in any of the four activities arranged for Monday morning.





This emergency cover by a reputable provider, will give our members peace of mind, knowing that, for the first time, the day to day inherent risk in the field and lodgings is now covered.

SECTION 16A

Custodians is accredited with the Central Firearms Registry and can award Section 16A "Professional Hunter Status" in terms of the Firearms Control Act to active professional hunters. That would allow members license their to firearms as professional hunters. The Association can also endorse motivations for new or renewal firearm licence applications.


